2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3           Relating to Class 8 municipalities; to authorize an  
4 elected official of the municipality to designate a person to  
5 serve in his or her place on any state or local agency, board,  
6 commission, or other entity; and to prohibit the elected  
7 official from appointing a convicted felon to serve as his or  
8 her designee unless that person has had his or her civil  
9 rights restored.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

11           Section 1. (a) In Class 8 municipalities, an elected  
12 official of the municipality who is an ex officio member of a  
13 state or local agency, board, commission, or other entity  
14 pursuant to law, may designate a person to serve in his or her  
15 place, who shall assume all duties of the elected official  
16 relating to the entity, including all voting rights and who  
17 shall be counted as a member for the purpose of conducting  
18 business. Provided, that the elected official may not appoint  
19 a convicted felon to serve in his or her place unless that  
20 person has had his or her civil rights restored.

21           A designee appointed by the mayor to serve in his or  
22 her place is not required to be a resident of the municipality  
23 where the mayor serves.

24           (b) A designee under subsection (a) shall serve at  
25 the pleasure of the elected official and for the duration of

1 the elected official's term of office and an elected official  
2 may withdraw a designee's appointment and appoint a new  
3 designee at any time.

4 (c) This section applies to a general or local law  
5 enacted prior to, on, or after the effective date of this act.

6 Section 2. This act shall become effective  
7 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
8 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
