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ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to Fayette County, to amend Section 45-29-110 of the Code of Alabama 1975, to further provide for the compensation of poll workers.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 45-29-110 of the Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"§45-29-110.

"(a) The county commission of Fayette County shall provide such additional amount of daily compensation as is necessary to grant each election clerk, inspector, and returning officer of elections a total compensation of twenty-five dollars (\$25), and shall increase the mileage allowance of the returning officer to fifteen cents (\$.15) a mile in going to the courthouse and returning to the place of holding the election. Such compensation and mileage shall be paid out of any funds in the county treasury available for such purposes.

"(b) (1) In Fayette County, all inspectors, assistant inspectors, and technical assistants appointed to conduct elections at the various polling places are hereby entitled to an additional per diem allowance in such amount as will, together with any amount paid by the state, make a total paid to such officials thirty-five dollars (\$35) for each day they

1 work at the polls. Such officials, when acting as returning
2 officers, shall also be entitled to such mileage allowance as
3 may be prescribed by law.

4 "(2) In Fayette County, all clerks appointed to
5 conduct elections at the various polling places are hereby
6 entitled to an additional per diem allowance in such amount as
7 will, together with any amount paid by the state, make a total
8 paid to such officials twenty-eight dollars (\$28) for each day
9 they work at the polls.

10 "(3) If the amount paid to such officials as
11 compensation or expense allowance by the state increases in
12 the future, then the amount paid by the county under this
13 subsection shall automatically decrease in a like amount.

14 "(4) The expense allowances provided for in this
15 subsection shall be paid from the general fund of the county.

16 "(c) In addition to the compensation provided in
17 subsections (a) and (b), the county commission shall provide
18 to each poll worker who works at a polling place in the
19 county, together with any amount paid by the state pursuant to
20 general law, an amount of compensation to make the total
21 compensation of each poll worker a minimum of one hundred
22 dollars (\$100) for each day the poll worker works at the polls
23 during an election."

1 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
2 first day of the third month following its passage and
3 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
