Article I	32	Slavery prohibited; involuntary servitude	The language “, otherwise than for the punishment of crime, of which the party shall have been duly convicted” has been removed.
Article III	43.02	Administration of County Affairs (Amendment 909)	In paragraph (d), [repeal] has been deleted and “repel” has been restored.
Article IV	111.05	Effectiveness of unfunded mandates for municipalities, etc. (Amendment 621; Amendment 890)	In (8), after “board” [of] has been deleted.
Article V	137	Duties generally and restrictions on receipt of fees, etc., by attorney general, state auditor, secretary of state, state treasurer, and commissioner of agriculture and industries; annual reports by state treasurer and state auditor; attorney general may be required to defend suits against state, political subdivisions, officers, etc. (Amendment 111)	Between the words “offices” and “if required”, a comma has been restored.
Article VII	176	Limitation on impeachment penalties; accused person liable to indictment and punishment. (Amendment 904)	In the first line of the paragraph, [do] has been deleted and [does] has been restored.
Article XI	213.21	Indebtedness by state for forensic sciences laboratories and education facilities. (Amendment 620)	In the third paragraph, the words “of the” after “approval” and before “Governor” have been deleted.
Article XI	213.35	Alabama Music Hall of Fame Authority. (Amendment 489)	In paragraph VII, [the] has been deleted and in its place “e” has been restored.
Article XI	213.38	Road bond issue amendment. (Amendment 11)	The phrase “Section 1” was restored at the beginning of the first paragraph.

Article XI	215.03	Special county tax for public hospital purposes. (Amendment 76)	In the first paragraph, after “include” and before “public” a comma was deleted.
Article XI	219.07	Acquisition, maintenance and protection of unique lands and water areas. (Amendment 543)	In Section 2, (1) and (2), the word “this” has been changed to “the”. In Section 7, (a), the phrase “Amendment Number 450 to this Alabama Constitution of 1901. [§219.02]” has been deleted twice and “219.02” has been put in its place; in (c), the phrase, “Amendment or Amendment to this Alabama Constitution of 1901 [§219.02]” has been deleted and the phrase “Section or §219.02” has been put in its place. In Section 10, the word “unenforceable” has been deleted and the word “unforceable” has been restored.
Article XVI	256	Educational policy of state; authority of legislature to provide for or authorize establishment and operation of schools by persons, municipalities, etc.; grant, donation, sale or lease of funds and property for educational purposes; election of certain schools for attendance by parents of minors. (Amendment 111)	In the first paragraph, the comma after “legislature” has been deleted. The language “, to require or impose conditions or procedures deemed necessary to the preservation of peace and order” has been deleted.
Article XVI	259	Use of poll taxes for support and furtherance of education. (Amendment 111)	This section has been repealed in its entirety.
Article XIV	260.02	Education Trust Fund Rainy Day Account (Amendment 803)	In Section II, fourth paragraph, a comma

			has been restored between the words “leasing” and “or”. In the same paragraph, a comma has been restored between the words “gas” and “or”.
Article XIV	266	Board of Trustees of Auburn University (Amendment 161, Amendment 670, Amendment 906)	In paragraph (h), after the word “expiration”, [of] has been deleted.
